

The following freshman scholarships are available to international students classified as non-Florida residents through Undergraduate Admissions. Meeting or exceeding the posted criteria does not guarantee selection for a scholarship. To be considered for these awards, you must [apply](#) for admission by January 2nd; applications received after this date will be considered only if funds are available. Refer to the [admissions checklist](#) to complete your application. Review your residency classification by checking [OASIS](#). If selected for a scholarship, you will receive notification by mail, and you will be able to view and accept your scholarship on [OASIS](#).

You are only eligible to receive one of the non-Florida resident scholarships; however, you may be eligible to receive one or more of the "stackable" scholarships in addition to the non-Florida resident scholarships.
