PLAYERS AND ATTIRE

Each team will consist of two (2) players. A maximum of four (4) may be on the roster.

No jewelry or any objects that may cause injury to another player are allowed.

GAME, COURT, AND EQUIPMENT

Boundary lines shall consist of two sidelines and two end lines marking the playing court.

The serving zone is behind the end line and between the extensions of the sidelines.

Teams must provide their own ball.

LENGTH OF GAME AND TIME CONSTRAINTS

All games will have a thirty (30) minute time limit.

Games are rally scoring and played to twenty (20) points; a team must win by two (2) points, with a twenty-five (25) point cap.

The third game, if necessary, is played to fifteen (15) with a cap of twenty (20).

Each team is entitled to a maximum of one (1) timeout per game, lasting for thirty (30) seconds.

SUBSTITUTIONS AND TIEBREAKERS

Substitutes are only allowed in between games unless there is an injury.

DEFINITION OF PLAYING TERMS

All other rules will be based upon 2000-2001 Official United States Beach Volleyball Rules.

PLAYER CONDUCT

Participants must refrain from any actions aimed at delaying the game.

Unsportsmanlike conduct by a team member toward officials, opponents, or spectators is an automatic ejection and termination from the tournament.
