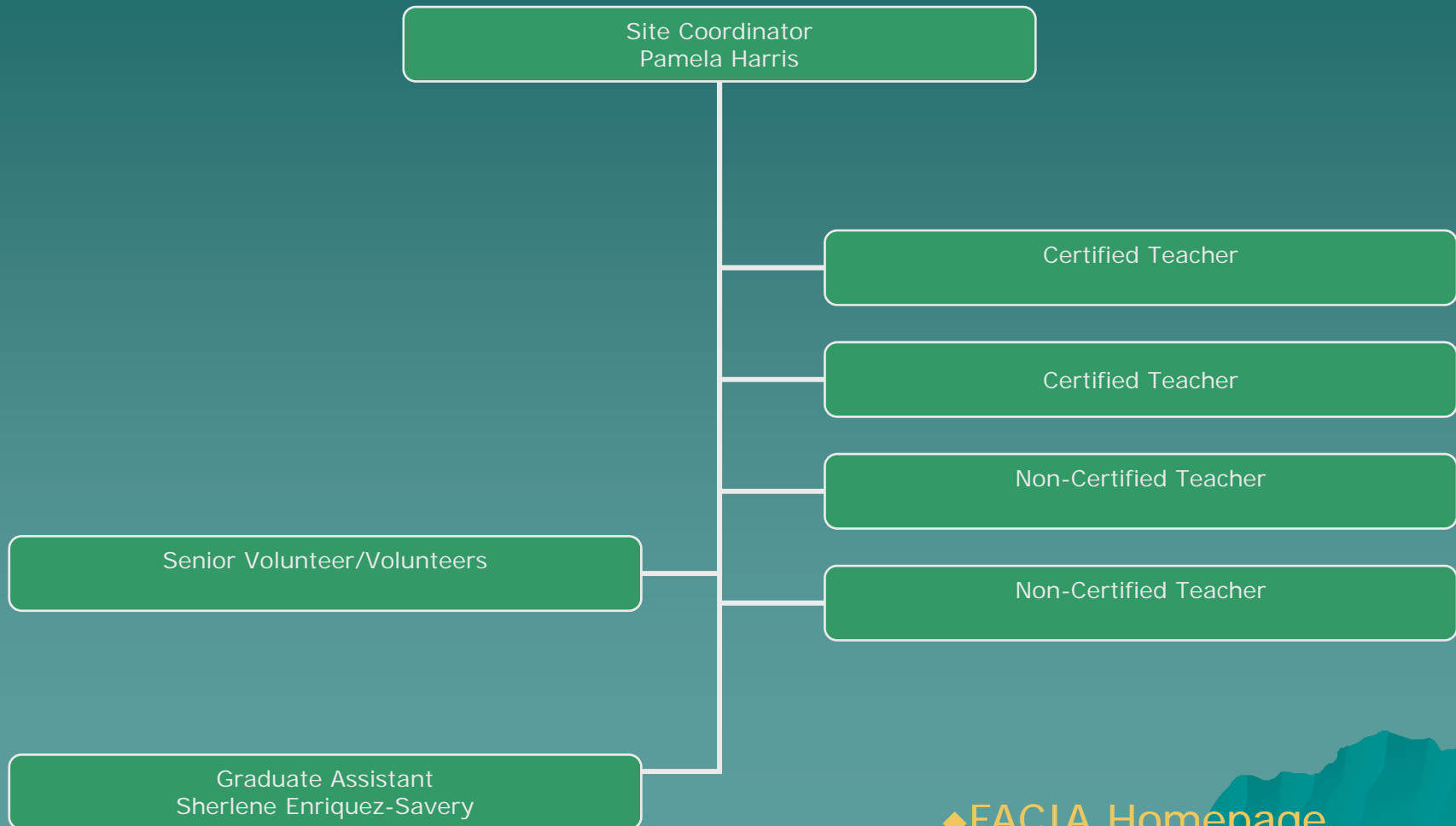


Site Coordinator Wuillene Paul
