Recommended for Repeal:

S. 20, Article X of the state constitution prohibits tobacco smoking in enclosed indoor workplaces. This prohibition was adopted in 2002. Additionally, the constitution states that "..., nothing in this section or in its implementing legislation or regulations shall prohibit the owner, lessee, or other person in control of the enclosed indoor workplace from further prohibiting or limiting smoking therein." The Constitution charges the Legislature with implementing this section, which has been done via the Florida Clean Indoor Air Act, 386.201-386.212 FS.

255.27 has been eliminated.
